OTHER PROJECTS



400 HYGIENE PACKS DONATED THROUGH EFFORTS BY WEHERO

We received a generous donation of 400 hygiene packs from WeHero for Ukraine in the New Year. With the help of our volunteers, the packs were neatly arranged in 20 boxes and taken to Suvenýry.com in Prague 6. Suvenýry/com took on the task of branding the 400 cloth bags, each filled with essential hygiene items like socks, vaseline, toothbrush, toothpaste, aspirin, shower gel, and shampoo. We are truly thankful to Suvenýry.com for their support and generosity. As a donation in kind, they kindly did not charge us for their work, only for the actual printing on each bag.



EARTHQUAKES IN TURKEY & SYRIA

Three Rotary Districts in Turkey were preparing to apply for Rotary Disaster Response Funds. Our plan involved assembling Family Help Boxes to be delivered to the Turkish Embassy in Prague for the earthquake victims. These aid packages were then flown to Turkey by the Embassy. RC Bristol Breakfast pledged to donate 1,000GBP to DAEurope for the benefit of the victims in both Turkey and Syria. Additionally, 500 GBP was collected through bucket collections outside a supermarket just a few days after the earthquakes. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to the DAE members who diligently packed 350 DAEurope-branded hygiene packs into boxes. These boxes, along with sleeping bags and warm clothing, were scheduled for delivery to the Turkish Embassy on the following day, in a concerted effort to support those affected by the earthquakes.



WEHEROES COOPERATION

WeHeroes organized a corporate volunteer day with Avantor Scientific in Belgium last year, resulting in the creation of 400 hygiene packs sent to Ukraine and the Turkish Embassy in Prague through DAEurope. In April they organised another such volunteer day at the Avantor Scientific European Sales Conference in Lisbon to assemble 1,000 hygiene packs (500 for men & 500 for women) to be distributed to the Ukraine via DAEurope. They invited Stuart to join the event in Lisbon to capture the moment, with WeHeroes covering the costs of his flights and accommodation. The collective efforts aim to provide essential support to those in need in the Ukraine.



DAEUROPE, DA USA & UJETA VISIT TO TURKEY

Stuart visited Adana, Turkey, from Monday 24th April to Thursday 27th April. Joining him on this important trip is Drita, the CEO of Ujeta GmbH and Larry from DA USA. Their mission was to conduct a Needs Assessment in the sTurkish Districts' Container City, with a specific focus on providing clean drinking water. A Container City is currently under construction in Hatay, approximately 2 hours away from Adana, comprising 220 container homes. Rotary District 2430, led by District Governor Dr. Emre Ozturk, plays a key role in organizing this effort, with the support of the other two Turkish Rotary Districts.
